There are *three* methods of administration for the PLS-5 (English, Spanish only, and Dual Language) and *four* ways of entering the data (English, Spanish, Dual language score only, and Dual language score & Spanish score). Updates have been made to Chapter 4 of the LEP manual reflecting this information and instructions for Dual Language and Spanish-only administration!

Thank you to everyone who was able to attend Data Camp this year!

Wednesday at Data Camp, LEPs and National Partners at FPG made progress on papers, collaborated on Educare processes, and received support from FPG DMAC team. Small process group topics included topics such as LEP processes, Tableau, Dual language assessments, and LEPs and data utilization.

In whole group time on Thursday, Gary Bingham led a session on using data, and small groups had discussions around data use and collaboration principles.
