PPVT Sampling - Birthday rule

Every spring, 50% of all Educare children in their "Head Start" years, with parental consent, should be given the PPVT assessment. To select your 50% sample, please assess any age-eligible child with a birthday in an even-numbered month (February, April, June, etc.) More guidance is available in Chapter 5 of the LEP manual

LEP-NEP Community of Practice - 6/9/23

The network welcomed members from the new Long Beach LEP team - Traci Shirachi and Brandin Ali with The Mark USA!

Guests from FPG, Adam Holland and Schatzi McCarthy, joined to present about accountability practices in DEIB work. The group asked questions and discussed accountability for this work in the Educare network.

The group then had discussion about Spring Parent Survey completion rates and strategies to engage parents and respond to any of their concerns regarding surveys.

Sue Rasher shared about the EREDS meeting, where the group discussed changes to the governance structure and how to have conversations with and implement the research agenda at sites in the network. The research agenda is being translated into Spanish.

Spring Parent Surveys:

- Preload files can still be uploaded to the EIS system - contact Keil if you do so he can generate the file of links
- If your site is using paper surveys, uploading a preload file will save you from having to enter names, DOBs on every single survey when doing data entry
