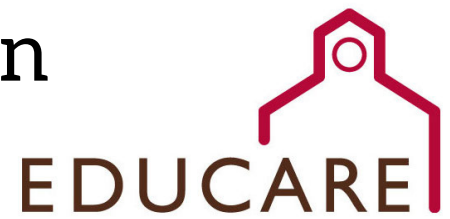

### Reminders

#### Select Fall Parent Interview option

LEPs should meet with their site leadership to select which Fall Parent Interview option they will use for 2024-25. The mini interview is now an option for sites struggling with response rates. #### PPVT-4/5

All children born in an even-numbered month and eligible for Kindergarten in 2024-25 or 2025-26 should be assessed.

For 2023-24, PPVT-4 data will be included in processed datasets. FPG's website will accept PPVT-5 data but will not be updated to confirm scores for the PPVT-5 nor will PPVT-5 data be included in processed datasets. You can request paper PPVT-4 forms from Linda Soto at FPG
