Conference presentations, papers, and proposed studies must be reviewed by the Educare Research Evaluation and Data Strategy Work Group. Papers should be reviewed before submission; conference presentations can be reviewed after they are accepted but at least two weeks prior to the presentation. At our last meeting...

Educare Network Meeting - May 6-9

LEPs had the opportunity at the network pre-meeting day to sit with their school partners to think together about their work as an RPP, including shifts due to the federal landscape, practices leveraged to navigate these times, and possibilities moving forward. We also talked about the ways schools use the current battery of data collected and what other data is needed.

The LEP-NEP Community of Practice meeting on Wednesday was a frank discussion of folks’ feelings after the pre-meeting day, how we are dealing with the current federal context, how we would like to move forward as a research network, and the decision-making structure. This conversation was cut short to join practice partners in other communities of practice, but it was continued at lunch the next day. This will be an ongoing topic of discussion between LEPs, FPG, and the National Office/Start Early.
