PPVT-4/5

Based on a survey of LEPs, EREDS members, and program folks, and previous discussions, EREDS has decided that *as of 2024-25*, the PPVT will no longer be included in the required battery of assessments. **Please complete PPVT data collection this spring and finish out strong!**

For 2023-24, PPVT-4 data will be included in processed datasets. FPG's website will accept PPVT-5 data but will not be updated to confirm scores for the PPVT-5 nor will PPVT-5 data be included in processed datasets. You can request paper PPVT-4 forms from Linda Soto at FPG

LEP-NEP Community of Practice - 10/13/23

Iheoma led a group discussion about publishing papers and presentations using network data and about our processes. Allison lead a discussion about the logic model that has been worked on over the past several weeks - EREDS and a few additional LEPs will create an ad hoc group to consolidate the logic model and think about metrics.

The National Evaluation team gave reminders about the fall parent interview, using the classroom observation coversheet with CLASS and ITERS-3 data collection, and attendance and disabilities completion.
