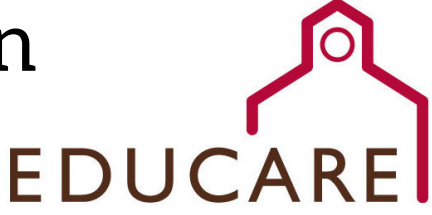

Conference presentations, papers, and proposed studies must be reviewed by the Educare Research Evaluation and Data Strategy Work Group. Papers should be reviewed before submission; conference presentations can be reviewed after they are accepted but at least two weeks prior to the presentation. 2024-25 Attendance & Disabilities

This is the first step to completing your attendance and disabilities files for the 2024-25 school year. First, download your error report from the EIS site. Once you have corrected any errors, then you can download and complete your attendance and disabilities files.

Tip: the dates open/closed fields of the attendance file can be ignored unless the site is experiencing classroom closures, opening a new classroom mid year, etc.

At our last meeting...

LEP-NEP Community of Practice - October 10

Allison facilitated a session on asset-driven storytelling. Small groups shared stories related to dreaming, designing, and envisioning prompts. For example, “tell us a story or memory that reminds you of the future you’re working toward”. At our November CoP meeting, Dr. Anjali Ferguson is joining us. Dr. Anjali Ferguson is a culturally responsive psychologist and global resource on treating racial trauma and its mental health effects on children and families. Her commitment to social equity is experienced through her online community Parenting Culture– a research-informed, inclusive space for open conversations around parenting and her landmark contributions to Blindian (Black + Indian) literature.

Noreen shared an update about the current state of the Educare Network. Noreen, representing FPG, is having monthly meetings with the President of the Network, Dr. Kara Ahmed, the BECF VP, and 5 executive directors. EDs will not be joining Data Camp this year, but there are plans to set up regular data dialogues to create a feedback loop between the national and local levels and initiate data conversations in RPPs
