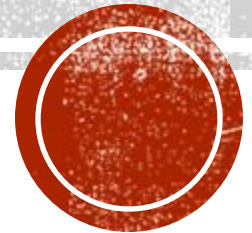

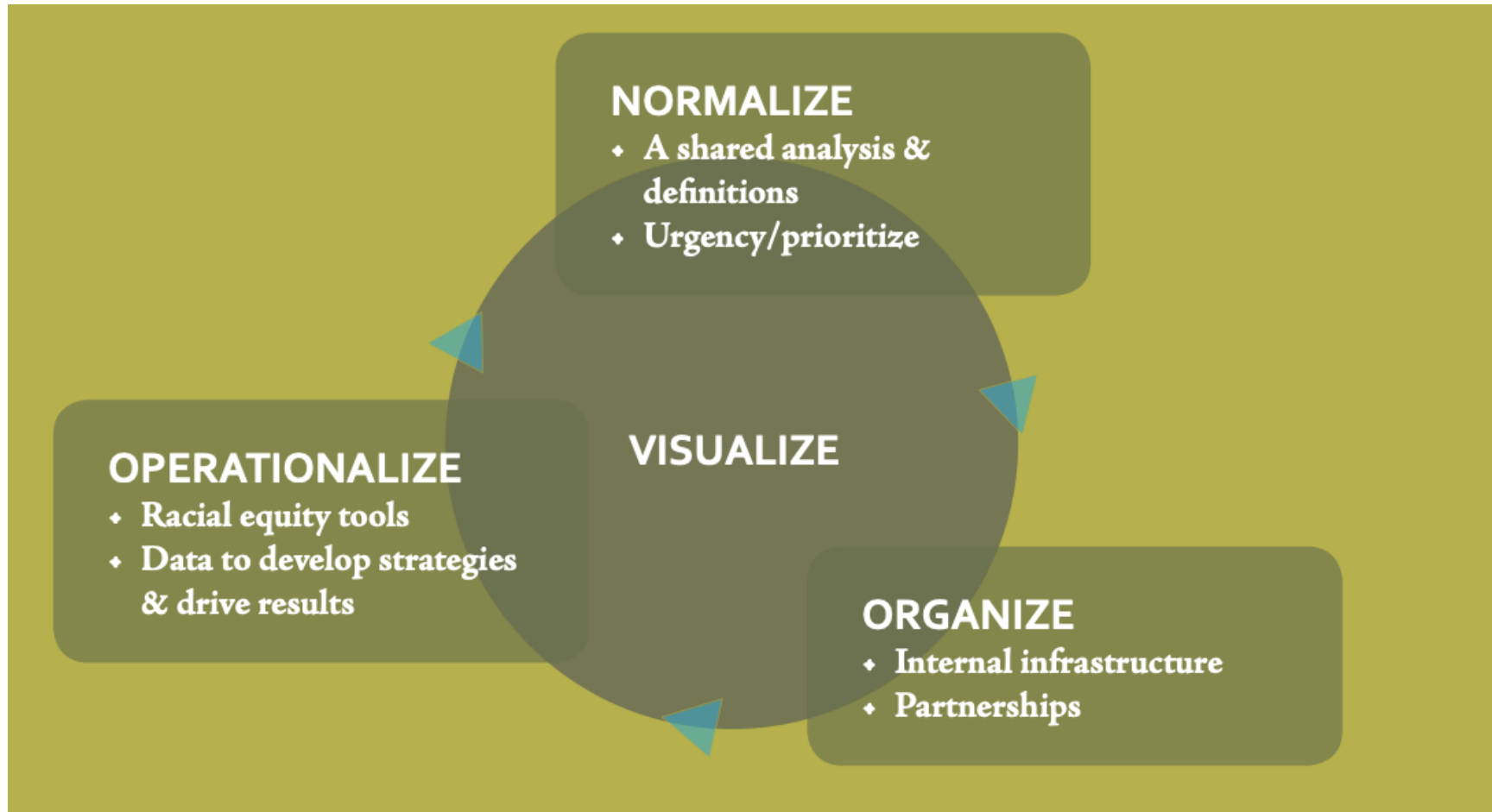

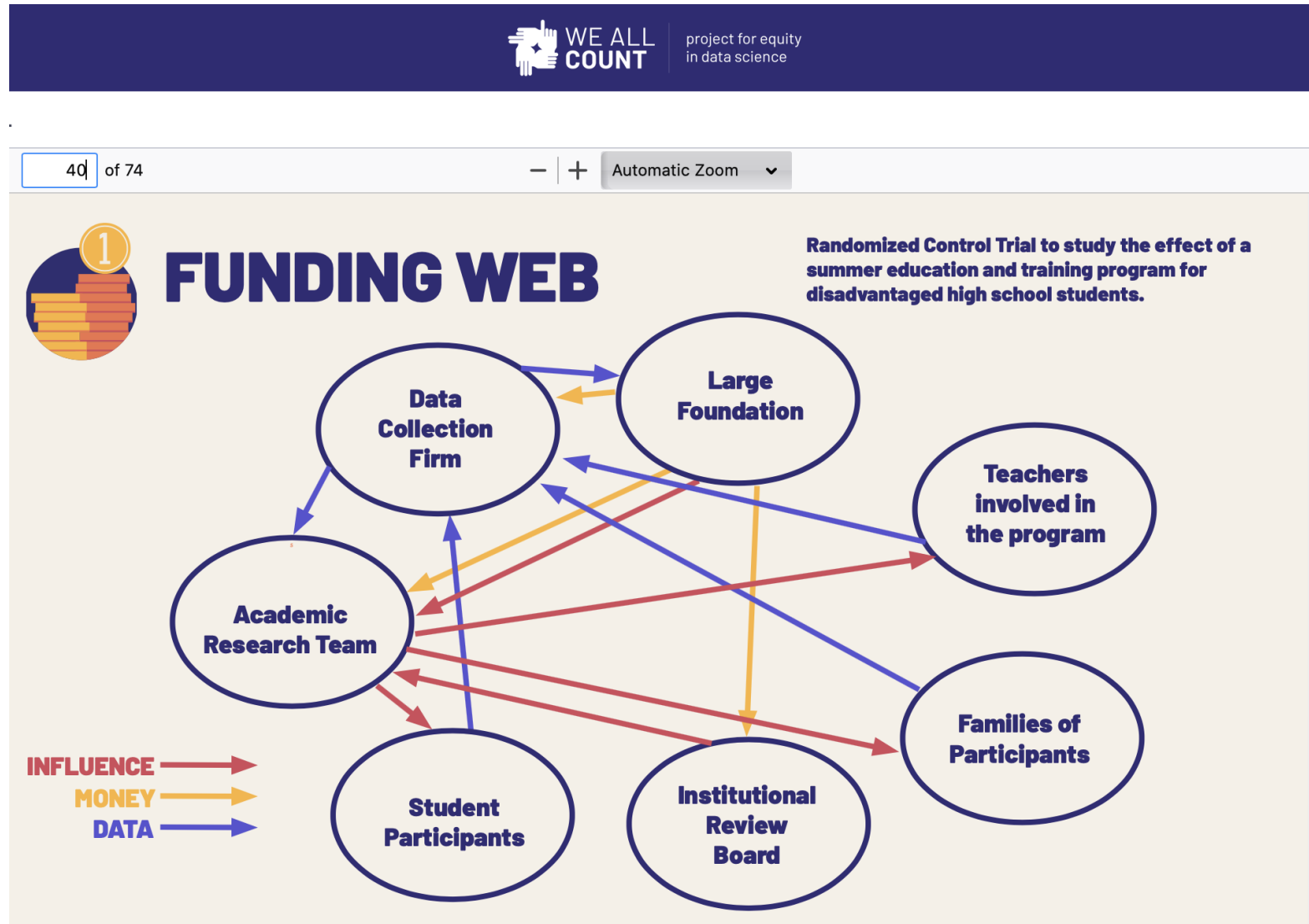
FUNDING WEB — AKA POWER/INFLUENCE ANALYSIS FOR RESEARCH

1. How is money, data, decision-making/influence flowing through your research?
2. Who is setting the value of the data?
3. Who is setting the prices?
4. Who determines access and use?

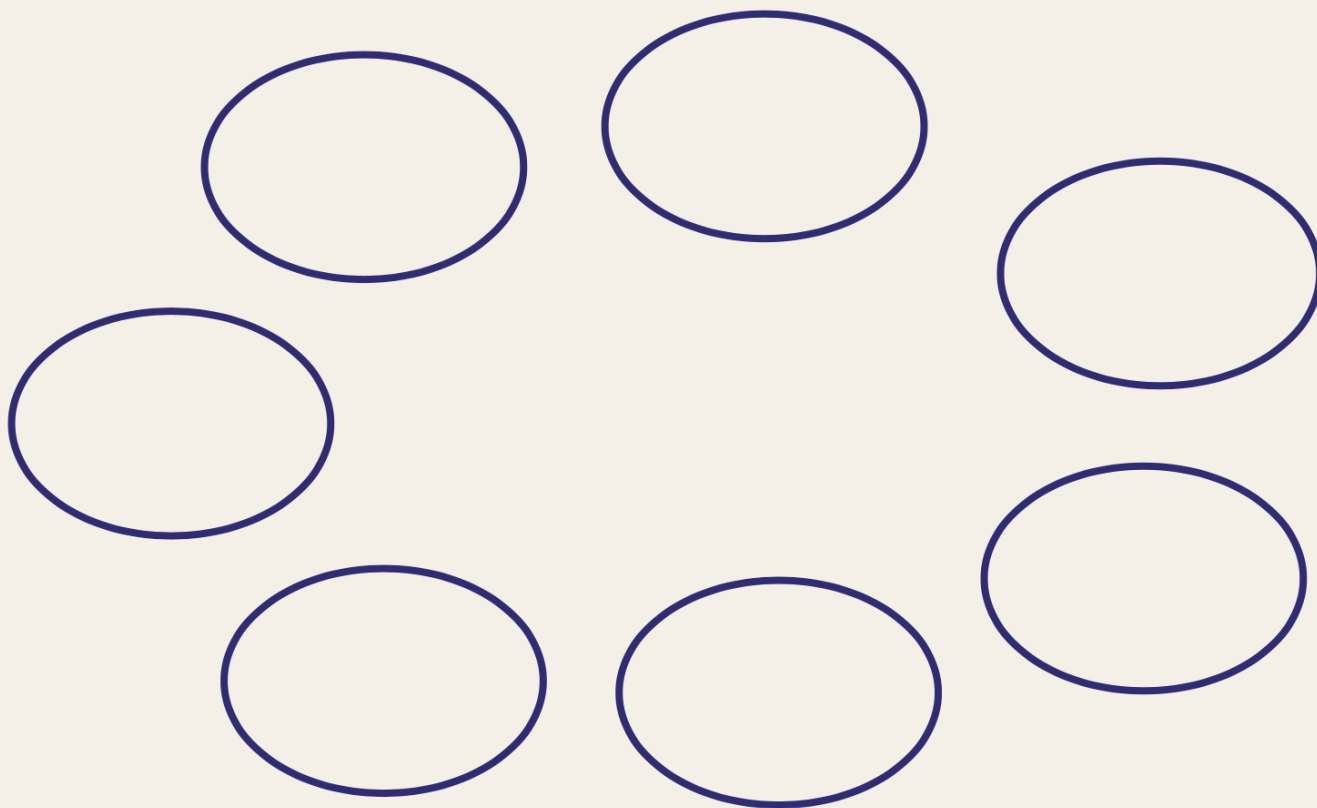

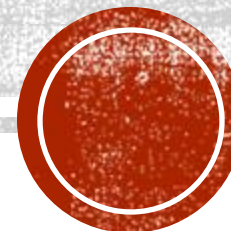
